Amendment to Local Enforcement of Speed Limits on a State Highway

Under authority granted by 24 V.S.A. Chapter 59, 23 V.S.A. § 1007 and 1008 and 13 V.S.A. § 7251, the Townshend Select Board hereby modifies and amends *Article 4, Section e*, of the, "Local Enforcement of Speed Limits On A State Highway," ordinance as adopted by the Town of Townshend on April 21, 2003, to read as follows:

- e. Proceeding 3.58 miles north on Vermont Route 30 within the Town of Townshend from a point 2.45 north of the Newfane/Townshend line and to a point 6.03 miles from the Newfane/Townshend line, the speed limit shall be 50 miles per hour;
- e.1. Proceeding 0.2 miles north from there to a point 6.23 miles north of the Newfane/Townshend line, the speed limit shall be 40 miles per hour.

All other sections in the aforementioned ordinance to remain the same.

Modification to this civil ordinance shall become effective 60 days after its adoption by the Townshend Select Board. If a petition is filed under 24 V.S.A. § 1973, the taking effect of this ordinance shall be governed by that statute.
