Minutes May 9, 2018

Present: John Evans; Robert DeSiervo, Brandon Canevari and Andrew Snelling Members of the public: Donnel Barnum and Laura Richardson (7:30 p.m.)

- 1. Call to Order: Chairman Evans called the meeting to order at 7:20 p.m.
- **2. Approval of the Minutes:** Canevari made a motion to accept the minutes of April 25, 2018 as submitted. The motion was seconded by Snelling and unanimously carried.

In the course of the discussion Snelling referenced the Permit Review Sheet for the project received from Department of Environmental Conservation & Natural Resources Board.
- 5. **Correspondence:** The draft of Newfane's updated town plan was examined by the Commissioners. Snelling indicated that he would attempt to attend the public hearing in Newfane on May 29th at 6:00 p.m.

Evans asked that Snelling look into the current availability of grants for assistance in updating the energy section.
