Draft Minutes August 28, 2019

1. Call to Order: Chairman Evans called the meeting to order at 7:25 p.m.

Village Center Designation: Canevari informed the Commission that we had received the required letter from Windham Regional Commission (WRC) stating the approval of Townshend's Town Plan and confirmation of the Town's planning process. In addition the Commission will need to notify WRC and Brattleboro Development Credit Corporation (BDCC) of the intention to apply for the Village Center Designation (VCD). Canevari presented drafts of the notification letters, which the Commission reviewed and edited. The revised versions were approved for mailing Canevari brought up several parts of the application which required input from the full Commission including the final boundaries. He stated that in his conversations with the Community Planning and Revitalization Department that they were not inclined to recommend approval of the VCD boundary including Valley Cares, because it is not contiguous with the rest of the village, is primarily residential and was not part of the traditional village area.

Snelling made a motion, seconded by Evans, to change the Northern VCD boundary to be the northern edge of the Grace Cottage property and the Southern boundary after Deb Sherman Painting. The motion carried unanimously.

Act 174: Snelling presented a draft of an Act 174 compliant energy element based on the WRC template with Townshend specific information. He stated that he was going to need some input from the full Commission on the policy

sections. Snelling said that the WRC deadline for a final draft is early November, so we will need to dedicate some time to working on the draft at our next several meetings.
