West Townshend VCD: No new update

Act 174 Energy Element: Snelling stated that he had emailed the latest version of the Energy Element to the Commissioners and solicited any final comments. He outlined the next steps in

getting the Energy Element adopted.

<u>Bike Path and Sidewalks:</u> After a discussion, Snelling moved that the Bike Path and Sidewalk issue be removed from the active project list. The motion was seconded by Martin and

carried unanimously.

7. **New Business:** Snelling provided a summary of the FEMA Discovery Mapping

project for the West River watershed and pointed out that there were proposed changes to the flood zones which could lead to changes in the Flood Insurance Rate Maps in a couple of years.
