Old Business: 6. <u>Town Plan:</u> Snelling presented an overview of the survey data

> and how the Commission might utilize it as community input for the twelve State required topics to be covered by municipal plans. There was a discussion of some of the items in the survey data. Ms. Tedrow stated that a prominent survey point was the need for more volunteers. However, she had encountered resistance in a recent attempt at volunteering. She also expressed that the Town's insurance requirements for the use of the Common and Town Hall were making it more difficult for local groups to utilize the facilities for community events. The commissioners agreed to each consider the survey data and have a further

discussion at the next meeting.

DeSiervo reported that it is permissible to make a Town Hall: presentation during the discussion of the motion on an article at Town Meeting. The Commissioners' then debated how best to inform the voters about the article and whether it was necessary to cover the larger plans for renovating the Town Hall. It was concluded that DeSiervo would prepare a brief presentation that would touch on the full Wesner proposal but focus on the initial phase of making the1st floor ADA compliant.

New Business: 7. Maintenance Check List: DeSiervo passed around a maintenance

> check list for the town hall which he had prepared several years ago. The commissioners agreed that it could be a useful tool to
