Superintendent's Report: Steven reported to the board that they will be getting a lot of information from the Legislature. Steven gave a verbal report to the board for the superintendent's report. Steven suggested to the board to pay attention to the VSB alerts. The message is we are not going to stay the same we have to change.

Steven gave a summary of budgets around the WCSU-LGUHS was even in terms of money; Dover had the greatest increase in budget at 9.8%, Windham's budget is up; Wardsboro is going to spend down some of their surplus and Townshend's budget is up 5% and tax rate up 5%.

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Brookline/Newfane budgets are up-Brookline is 9.6% and Newfane is up 6.4%.; Marlboro is down a fraction and Jamaica at 0% and no information of impact on taxes.

The consent calendar was approved unanimously.

Treasurer and financial reports: The Revenue statement as of January 31, 2015 was reviewed by the board and Steven and was reported to be in pretty good shape. Deborah will report on the Building and Maintenance line at a later date. It will be a lengthy discussion. Deborah said the UV Disinfection system is really costing the town money, it is constantly needing attention. Steven thinks we need to pursue this water issue and he will talk with someone at the state level and report back to the board with his findings.

Bills and Purchase Orders: Al made a motion to pay the bills and purchase orders as follows: Payroll PO#48 \$16,007.90, Payroll PO#49 \$7,272.06, Payroll PO#50 \$17,724.32, Payroll PO#51 \$12,848.93 and Payroll PO#52 \$17,809.45. No discussion. Motion carried to pay bills and purchase orders as read.
