Hazard Mitigation Plan Meeting May 8, 2024 Minutes Approved: 5/14/24

Alyssa Sabetto introduces the Discussion on;

- 1. The definition of Mitigation: Any sustained action taken to reduce likelihood of damage to people and property from disasters. Mitigation is a type of action not an event. The purpose is look ahead and make a plan to avert possible damage.
- 2. Reason for Hazard Mitigation Plan and an update to the plan: having HMP will ensure funding from FEMA and the State of Vermont Emergency Relief Assistance Fund (ERAF).
- 3. Sabetto leads a discussion on ranking the most vulnerable population and assets.
- 4. Discussion on the survey responses regarding hazard concerns.

Next Steps:

- 1. Sabetto will send hazard ranking response graph.
- 2. Sabetto will provide the informational powerpoint to Townshend.
- 3. Townshend will get the last two HMP's to use as reference.
- 4. Townshend will obtain a VTrans Map.
- 5. Sabetto will provide Townshend a copy of the Dummerston HMP to use as reference.
- 6. Residents will send pictures of hazards or damages from hazards (flooding, invasive species, wind etc.).
- 7. Schedule the second informational meeting. Possible date of July 10, 2024.
